The Sam Schmidt Paralysis Foundation helps individuals overcome spinal cord injuries and other neurological disorders by funding scientific research, medical treatment, rehabilitation and technology advances. The Foundation also raises funds to improve quality of life issues and ensure the best possible outcomes by touching individual lives. After becoming spinal cord injured from a crash during a practice session in 2000, Sam Schmidt founded SSPF. Wanting to return to what he loved most, racing, he formed Sam Schmidt Motorsports (SSM) and is now a successful Indy Racing League team owner winning the 2004, 2006 and 2007 Pro Series Championships. SSM receives no support from the Foundation; however, the team's visibility and successes benefit SSPF. Day at the Races was created for individuals with disabling injuries to provide inspiration information, and explain what Sam Schmidt did when he was diagnosed a quadriplegic.
